About the Composition

Aberystwyth (pronounced *a-béris-twith*) is a hymn tune composed by Welsh composer, Joseph Parry (1841–1903). The tune takes its name from a small town on the west coast of Wales where Parry lived at the time he composed it. Many consider *Aberystwyth* to be the greatest English hymn ever written.

Aberystwyth Variants opens with a rousing introduction based on motives from the hymn tune. The first variation (*Andante*) presents the tune contrapuntally and in its original minor mode. The second variation (*Poco più mosso*) explores the major mode; introduced by a woodwind quartet, this melodious variation contrasts the woodwind and brass choirs. An aggressive march variation presents the tune in canon and in compound meter. The percussion section takes the lead in the fourth variation (m. 74). Contrasting timbres, fragmented phrases, mixed meters, bitonality, and shifting tonal centers give this variation a developmental instability. The final variation (*Sostenuto*) begins with a broad statement of the tune in the major mode by the brass and low reeds, breaks into a lively march with a low brass counter melody (m. 115), and reaches a climactic, *tutti* passage (*Maestoso*). The introduction material is restated (*Con spirito*) and expanded with a brief coda that brings the composition to a spirited close.

This composition is dedicated to Paul D. Freeman, friend and master music educator (Lexington, North Carolina).

About the Composer

Dr. William Harbinson is a Professor of Music Theory at Appalachian State University. He has received eight Editor's Choice Awards (Pepper Music Catalog) that identify "the very best of the new music available." His works for band appear on the contest/festival literature lists of several states. His symphonic work *Kallalanta* won the Merle J. Isaac Senior Composition Competition in 2007. His concert band work *All the Starry Band* was awarded the 2006 Hinda Honigman Cup from the North Carolina Federation of Music Clubs, and his symphonic orchestra work *Lake Dance* received the same award in 2011. His composition for brass and percussion *The Maestro's Flourish* won the Dallas Wind Symphony Fanfare Competition in 2005. He received the 100 Scholars Award from Appalachian State University (2008) signifying his sustained record of creative activity. He received a UNC Board of Governors Excellence in Teaching College Award in 2014. Phi Mu Alpha presented him with the Orpheus Award (2009) for his significant and lasting contributions to music in America.
