

Program Notes

Adir Hu is a melody that is traditionally sung during the Nizrah at the conclusion of the Passover Seder. This Jewish hymn expresses hope in the future for the Messiah's return and the reconstruction of God's sacred temple. In arranging this piece, I likened the "sacred temple" to a turbulent present-day world which desperately needs to be rebuilt with peace for all.

Exact translation

Adir Hu, Adir Hu Yivneh veito bekarov, Bimheirah, bimheirah, Beyameinu beka'rov

Benei veit-cha beka'arov.

Mighty is God. May God rebuild his temple. Speedily in our time, soon.

Pronunciation

Adir hu: Ah-deer hoo

Yivneh veito bekarov: Yiv-nay veh-toh beh-kah-rov

Bimheirah, bimheirah: Bihm-hey-rah, bihm-hey-rah

Beyameinu beka'rov: beh-yah-may-noo beh-kah-rov

Benei veit-cha* beka'arov: beh-nay veht-cha beh-kah-rov

*The (ch) is a guttural sound as if pronouncing the letter (K) with air behind it.
