### **Program Notes**

*Rise up Shepherd and Follow* is one of the most beautiful of the African-American Christmas Spirituals.

The sopranos should begin the piece by singing the melody in solo style while keeping the tone warm and expressive. In turn, the accompanying parts should provide the sopranos with a full, yet not overpowering harmonic support.

In m. 8, the tenors should maintain the warmth of tone created by the sopranos in their opening statement, followed by the basses in m. 15. Although the sopranos resume the melody in m. 17, the altos should also bring out the counter melody through m. 20.

Even though the dynamic marking is *forte* in m. 25, the urgency of tone should not sound like a "command" but rather, like an announcement of "good tidings of great joy." And finally, the piece should culminate with the benevolent summons to "follow."

### About the Arranger

Robert L. Jefferson is an experienced vocalist, songwriter, recording artist and pianist. Highly sought as a performer and clinician, he has taught all grade levels, Pre-K-college, and continues to serve as organist and music director for churches of various denominations. He has also performed with major symphonic orchestras and in concert halls throughout the United States and abroad.

Jefferson has presented workshops and clinics at Music Educators National Conferences, churches, colleges and universities.
