EDITOR'S LETTER

Much of my role as Choral Editor includes not only highlighting great selections from our fabulous writers and arrangers as well as wonderful materials to aid in teaching the pieces, but also helping educators achieve larger gains in the classroom and in concert settings. The challenges we face are both real and unique, yet they vary from school to school and state to state.

What should we do? Be the best TEACHERS possible! A lot has certainly changed, but I would like for you to consider a return to the BASICS, because the basics of good choral singing have not changed. While the basics are not magical, when they are implemented in every choral rehearsal, rehearsals begin to become magical!

For me, it all begins with a foundation of:

- 1. Good tone, which includes intentional, unified vowel production
- 2. A system of musical literacy that meets your students where they are
- 3. Rhythm readiness and skill building that crescendos throughout the year, song by song, concert by concert.
- 4. Score study that leads to systematic lesson plans and efficient, well-disciplined choral rehearsals

It all begins with preparation, and part of that preparation is choosing repertoire that meets your students where they are and builds within them skills to take them to the next level. Remember, everything that we do at the beginning lays a foundation for the remainder of the year. With that being said, I urge you to consider a clear plan and the "right" repertoire as you commit to what you are going to teach, how you are going to teach it, and whom you are teaching. The music in our new collections is designed to fit a spectrum of needs while also consistently lifting your students to new levels of skill and confidence in performance. As you plan out your teaching milestones for the year, focusing on technique, precise tone production, and sight-reading with your students, you are investing in so much more than just music education; you're encouraging young singers to open their hearts to a community in which every voice contributes meaningfully to a sound that is beautifully unique to the ensemble.

I hope that the comments, teaching strategies, and composer insights in this magazine help you bridge a connection between the composer's mind and the hearts of those you are teaching to bring the music to life. Wishing you a year filled with positive relationship building, special musical moments, and memories that will last you and your students a lifetime.

Coty Raven Morris

Who I Want to Be

A native of New Orleans, Coty Raven Morris spent the early years of her life in Louisiana. Her earliest musical experiences involved singing with her church choir and learning call and response chants while at summer camp. Morris relocated to Texas as a teenager, where she continued her musical journey through singing in school choirs. She went on to obtain her Bachelor's Degree from Texas State University, where she studied with Drs. Lynn Brinckmeyer, Jonathan Babcock, and Joey Martin. In 2020, She received her Master's Degree in Choral Conducting from Michigan State University, under the tutelage of Drs. David Rayl, Jonathan Reed, and Sandra Snow.

While a choral director at Crosby High School in the fall of 2020, Ms. Morris began incorporating new techniques into her teaching as a means of helping her students cope with the pandemic, asking them to describe their feelings on notecards that they'd pick up while walking through the classroom door.

Students would write down and share their feelings and then, in collaboration with Ms. Morris and their classmates, create short, mantra-like phrases to help them to process those feelings. This means of emotional realization was, in fact, the impetus for Morris' "Who I Want To Be," (3L1217) a new SSA work in the BriLee 2022 collection that Morris co-wrote with fellow conductor, pianist, and composer Saleel Menon. Though borne out of individual sentiments, the inspiring and powerful message of this piece can speak to a wide variety of participants and listeners.

Ms. Morris is the founder of Being Human Together, a music education community striving to normalize difficult topics through conversation and connection. Morris also sings with Mirabai and the South Texas Vocal Artists and is currently a visiting professor at Portland State University. In addition to being a passionate musician, Morris is currently writing a children's book!

Kevin Phillip Johnson

A Choice to Change the World




Kevin Phillip Johnson is a composer, arranger, and conductor who is committed to honoring time-old musical traditions while also breathing new life into them through use of modern elements. The son of renowned jazz and blues singer and arranger Bill Johnson, Dr. Johnson taught himself piano and voice as a teenager, performing with his own group before receiving formal musical training at California State University, where he obtained both his Bachelor's and Master's degrees. He later earned his Doctoral degree from the University of Missouri-Kansas City Conservatory of Music.

Dr. Johnson has created over 300 psalm settings, eight mass settings, and a myriad of sacred song and Spiritual arrangements, including some revoicings of tunes written by his father, Bill. A practicing Catholic, Dr. Johnson currently serves as the Minister of Music at Our Lady of Lourdes

Catholic Church in Atlanta, GA. Dr. Johnson is also a tenured professor at Spelman College, where he teaches choral conducting, music theory, music technology, and has served as the director of the world-renowned Spelman College Glee Club for nearly 20 years. During his time in this role, he has not only arranged works for the young musicians in the Club, but also helped develop performance-oriented choreography and introduced use of traditional African instruments, such as the West African djembe, into concert settings. Additionally, he has collaborated with students on projects pairing their texts and his music, as is the case in his arrangements of "Children, Go Where I Send Thee" (CM9742 and CM9743), which couple his musical settings and a standard text with a rap created by Spelman alumnus Sarah Stephens Benibo, who was enrolled at the institution when she wrote it.

Dr. Johnson also has an original work entitled "A Choice To Change the World" (CM9744) in the 2022 collection, a powerful piece which involves both solo lines and four-part textures. As a recognized musical force, Dr. Johnson is in regular demand; he is currently in the midst of composing repertoire for three commission-based projects, with performances for each of these happening in 2023. As he simultaneously considers his legacy while looking to expand his musical horizons even further, one thing is clear: Dr. Johnson places no limits on his creative impulses and musical capabilities as he forges ahead.

More experienced teachers will value the various keys provided for the partner songs, particularly teachers who are sometimes challenged when transposition at the keyboard is needed to accommodate fluctuating vocal ranges. Songs are grouped by age, from younger to older, thus allowing mature beginners to work at a beginning skill level without the personal angst that arises from singing tunes that seem babyish. Voice testing models and other helpful teaching strategies are also included. There are multiple partner song resources available for building singing independence, but few are as comprehensive as Lon Beery's new offering."

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
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
